060.24 OPEN SPACES:

(a) **Mowing/Maintenance Issues**: Church Farm Fields footpath mowing. Additional quotes for this mowing will be obtained to comply with due diligence.

(b) Open Spaces:

Pet waste management on Church Farm Fields is proving a challenge. The 3 waste bins are being emptied twice a month. However, one of the bins is always full and overflowing, with the other 2 remaining almost empty although signs have been installed asking dog owners to use another bin instead of over filling one bin. The cost of additional waste collection is prohibitive. The Council agreed that to address this, the three small dog waste bins would be replaced with one large free standing dog waste bin, installed near the entrance. This Bin will be emptied twice a month. A sign will be installed asking dog owners, to please take their dog waste home with them if the bin is full. The verges on Sywell Road adjacent and opposite to Aldi are overgrown. A request to both Highways and Aldi to attend to these, will be sent.

(c) **Highways:** Sywell Road Closure August 12th for 3 weeks.

Offences seem to be throughout the week- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday. I can request some analytical work on this and will likely see slight increase if we search all recorded incidents for keywords "racing, cruise, etc", at the moment I have got this information from incidents tagged as "vehicle nuisance, vehicle-ASB". Although under-reporting seems to be an issue.

In relation to the injunction mentioned, this is still pending and sat with West Northants Council, unfortunately legal challenges out of force against person "unknown" injunctions for street racing are ongoing. This is a new type of injunctions and still subject to legal challenges. Northants Police (myself) have provided an impact statement for this and the affect street racing has on the communities.

NPT are aware of the racing issues and do attend to conduct patrols, albeit we haven't had a significant volume of recent reports of the meetings taking place so need to encourage more reporting. We are in contact with highways and have new messaging for the matrix boards in relation to street racing.

The issue itself is still open at the ROJAG and is a factor in each meeting in relation to Roads Policing and vehicle enabled ASB.

If the Parish would like I can make myself available and attend a future parish council meeting to discuss the issue, what we are doing and how greater reporting is needed to assist us and evidence that is an issue to support our injunction application.
